

NOTICE OF EMERGENCY INCIDENT

On May 2nd, the work on the localisation of the accident and the investigation of its possible causes continued.

In order to produce an absorptive screen, on the 2nd of May 900 tons of lead were deposited on the centre of the accident. After observation of the reactor, further measures will be taken.

21 persons from the Chernobyl district who were previously evacuated were transferred for treatment in Kiev on May 2nd, 18 persons were police officers and auxiliary police.

The Government Commission has decided to evacuate the "Pripyat" and "Komsomolets Polesya" state farms and Kalinin collective farm from the zone within 10 kilometres of the accident site, overall – from 12 population centres.

An additional information about the violations of the technological process during the experiment in turbogenerator No.8 of the 4th power unit was obtained during the meetings with intelligence sources.

An analysis of the facts related to the emergency incident was conducted based on the results of work with intelligence agents. The outline of a likely model of the accident was developed as a result of this work. This information will be used in further investigations, as well as in the identification of persons responsible for the causes of the accident.

An intelligence investigation team is preparing for a trip to Ivankov.

The decision has been made to evacuate the city of Chernobyl, either during the night from 3rd to 4th of May, or in the morning on the 4th of May.

The level of radioactivity in the accident zone is 1,000,000-1,500,000 $\mu\text{Sv}/\text{hour}$, and in the city of Chernobyl it is 320 $\mu\text{Sv}/\text{hour}$.
