

**Certificate for the city of Kiev and the Kiev region on radioactive contamination of surface
and underground waters in the capital of the Ukrainian SSR**

May 13, 1986

According to the Kiev State Sanitary and Epidemiological Station, as of 12:00 on May 13, the situation in Kiev was characterised by the following data:

- Gamma radiation in air dose rate 4.5-7.5 $\mu\text{Sv/hr}$, indoors 1.0-3.0 $\mu\text{Sv/hr}$;
- tap water activity in the Nivki area 37 Bq/L, in the Desna River 4.7 Bq/L;
- open water bodies within the city 3.7-37 Bq/L;
- artesian water 3.7 Bq/L;
- Dnieper water in the water intake area at the surface was 37 Bq/L; of 11 deep water intakes, 8 yielded readings of 37 Bq/L, and 3 intakes 370 Bq/L.
